

P137a BISTRO Project Status (7)

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BISTRO (B-field In STar forming Region Observations) is an international research project to make submillimeter linear polarization images of nearby star forming regions as one of the EAO/JCMT Large Programs, and it involves over 130 researchers in Canada, China, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, UK, Vietnam and the East Asian Observatory. This paper reports an update of the research program including; a) progress of the data taking (BISTRO-1 complete, BISTRO-2 ongoing), b) progress of publication (Oph C, Perseus B1, IC 5146), and c) an emerging picture of the evolution of magnetized ISM towards star formation.
