

V332a Recent results from the MAGIC Telescopes

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Since the first significant detections of gamma-ray sources in 2004 with the initial MAGIC telescope, the MAGIC collaboration has continuously worked on novel technical developments and year by year made exciting discoveries. Located at the Roque de Los Muchachos observatory on La Palma, Spain, the two 17m-diameter imaging atmospheric Cherenkov telescopes of MAGIC have significantly advanced very-high-energy astrophysics. This talk will update on recent scientific highlights from MAGIC in Galactic and extra-galactic astrophysics as well as fundamental physics, and discuss future prospects.
